	<p>What do photographs and written sources tell us about how our local high street was like before?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shops have changed, becoming more up-to-date.</li> <li>• The roads have changed, due to their being much more traffic.</li> </ul>	<p>How has our local high street changed?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When we go shopping, we choose our own items, not the shopkeeper.</li> <li>• The roads have changed, due to their being much more traffic.</li> <li>• More space needed for parking.</li> </ul>	<p>What was it like to shop for food years ago and how has shopping in our local area changed?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shopping was an important occasion and people dressed smart for it.</li> <li>• Due to there being no fridges or freezers, people shopped daily.</li> <li>• People didn't normally choose their own shopping in shops – a shop keeper sorted it for you.</li> </ul>
